Nursery	Read stories and rhymes to develop language. Read and sing nursery rhymes over again using the same actions and special emphasis every time. Role play together until stories become familiar.	Practise using 'pure sounds'. Use Fred Talk to teach oral blending. Teach children to name the pictures.	Teach a new sound every day for about 15 minutes (Set 1 single letter). Start teaching children to blend in small groups if they can read all the single letter Set 1 sounds speedily.
